

SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR THE PUBLIC

As part of the "**VINITALY AND THE CITY**" event, the following safety regulations shall apply. The prohibitions listed below must be observed:

- Bringing **SUITCASES, TROLLEYS, BAGS, and BACKPACKS** with a capacity exceeding **15 litres**.
- Bringing **AEROSOL SPRAYS** (including mosquito repellents, deodorants, sunscreen sprays, etc.).
- Bringing **AIR HORNS**.
- Bringing or possessing **WEAPONS, EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS, PYROTECHNIC DEVICES, SMOKE BOMBS, SIGNAL FLARES, STONES, KNIVES, or ANY OTHER SHARP OR BLUNT OBJECTS** that may be used to attack or injure others.
- Bringing or possessing **ILLEGAL DRUGS, POISONS, HARMFUL SUBSTANCES, or FLAMMABLE MATERIALS**.
- Bringing **ANIMALS OF ANY KIND OR SIZE** (except pets, which are permitted only if kept on a short leash and wearing a muzzle).
- Bringing **SELFIE STICKS** and **TRIPODS** (unless specifically authorized).
- Bringing **UMBRELLAS** and **POLES**.
- Bringing **DRONES** and **REMOTE-CONTROLLED AIRCRAFT**.
- Bringing **BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER SKATES, and HOVERBOARDS**.
- Bringing **TENTS** and **SLEEPING BAGS**.
- Displaying any material that obstructs the view of other spectators, interferes with emergency signage, or otherwise obstructs emergency escape routes and exits.
- Carrying out any form of commercial activity that has not been previously authorized in writing by the event organizer.
- Engaging in aggressive behavior towards security personnel or event staff.
- Damaging or tampering with the venue's structures, infrastructure, or facilities in any way.
- Climbing on railings, barriers, partitions, or any other structures not intended for public access or occupancy.
- Remaining in access routes, exit routes, or any other emergency escape routes.

Any person who is clearly and disturbingly intoxicated will be denied entry to the event. Anyone found to be in the same condition during the event and causing disturbance or nuisance to others will be removed from the venue.

Any additional measures deemed necessary to ensure the highest level of safety and the orderly conduct of the event may also be implemented.
